

## O'Keefe & Partners Scholarship

### The Award

The O'Keefe and Partners Scholarship is a biennial award fully supported by O'Keefe & Partners open to current financial members of ADAPE Australasia.

The Award confers one scholarship to a successful candidate in each ADAPE Chapter to the value of \$500.00, to be used in the following way:

- > to support the applicant's professional development in furtherance of innovation and/or attaining industry best practice
- > to support an ADAPE member individually, so thus to be used for services to further personal professional learning, not investment in technology or equipment

The Award is required to be utilised within 12 months of the award being announced.

### The Submission

Candidates for the O'Keefe's Scholarship are required to prepare a single A4 submission of no more than 350 words, detailing the following:

- > The likely use for the scholarship should be outlined in the submission, with reference to a particular course or event where possible
- > The benefits that would be attained from the receipt of the scholarship to the applicant's professional development in furtherance of innovation and/or attaining industry best practice

In addition to the submission, candidates are requested to provide:

- > A statement confirming that they are current financial members of ADAPE, and details of the Chapter to which they belong
- > Details of their current position and a brief statement regarding their primary activities
- > A brief letter of support from the applicant's manager eg: Principal, Vice-Chancellor, Director of Community Relations etc.

### Requirements of the successful candidate

The successful candidate will be required to:

- > Present a brief report at a professional development session to members of their ADAPE Chapter on the benefits accrued from the scholarship
- > Write a brief report on same, for the Face2Face magazine / e-news

### The Selection Committee

A committee of at least two but no more than three from each Chapter will select the successful candidate.

### Submissions

Submissions close on Friday, 5 February 2010.

The scholarship winner will be announced on Friday, 19 February 2010 by email to all Chapter members.

Applications should be e-mailed to Michele Dunn [adape@adape.org.au](mailto:adape@adape.org.au) and will then be forwarded to each individual judging committee.

**Late applications will not be accepted.**
